ACTION TAKEN REPORT

Sub: Curbing the menace of ragging following the AICTE Guidelines of 2009 as well as UGC Regulations, 2012 and UGC Regulations, 2016 in Higher Technical Institutions.

In view of the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court and as per the AICTE guidelines of 2009 as well as UGC Regulations, our institute (Durgapur Institute of Advanced Technology & Management) have implemented following measures of Anti ragging mechanism for the prevention and prohibition of ragging.

1. All admissions including hostel have to submit affidavit along with his/her application form that, he/she is also aware of the law in this regard and agrees to abide by the punishments meted out if he/she is found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging. Anti-Ragging warning are mentioned in the Institution's prospectus and information Booklets/ Brochures.
2. Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti Ragging Squad and Anti Ragging Cell comprised of teaching and non-teaching members, representatives of civil and police administration, local media, Non-Government Organizations involved in youth activities, representatives of parents, representatives of students belonging to the fresher's category as well as senior students. Anti-Ragging Squad is entrusted with the responsibility for maintaining vigil, oversight and patrolling functions.
3. Sufficient number of CCTV cameras are installed in vital points. Updated all institutional web sites with Nodal Officers complete details.
4. Anti-ragging workshops and seminars are held regularly on eradication of ragging in our Institution. Anti-Ragging posters are displayed at all prominent places such as Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. Regular interaction and counselling with the students are executed.
5. Surprise inspection of hostels, student accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, and any other measures which would assist in preventing / controlling ragging and any uncalled for behavior / incident has been commenced.

7. In spite of such measures of curbing the menace of ragging, any single untoward incident is dealt justifiably harsh to act as a warning against recurrence of such incidents.
8. The Anti-Ragging Committee, head of the institute and administrative, have every right to take an appropriate decision with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and gravity of the incident. The possible punishment for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level may be up to the rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.

The objectives/achievements of our Institute is to create a zero tolerance for ragging zone and prevent every student from physical and mental abuse. We are also responsible for the development of mental health and self-confidence of each and every fresher entering the campus.
